Rev250 meeting – New York state is requiring each town to have a celebration to honor the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States. Lauren has been attending meetings, kick-off is Community Day 2025 and fireworks and celebrations will continue throughout the year.

## Budget

Lauren needs to get her documents first, but also needs to incorporate \$8,000-10,000 into the budget for replacement mulch for a foot of depth each year.
